Biography



Mrs. Behide Hasanaj, was born on 20.04.1958 in Peja, from father Mustafë Adem Hasanaj and mother Shkurte Hasanaj Begolli. She finished elementary school in her hometown from 1964-1972. After elementary school, in 1975 she started a tailoring course practicing this profession for several years. In the 80's, she went to Sarajevo, where she began to work as a seamstress for the orphanage, where she taught the Croatian language. In 1983, Mrs. Behide Hasanaj emigrated to Switzerland, where she immediately began a volunteer mission to charities "Mother Teresa" and "Red Cross". In the same year, she completed the German language course at the highest levels. Thus, began her humanitarian activity, initially as a translator of the association in the Swiss municipalities. She was very capable of translating from German into Croatian and vice versa as well as from Albanian into German and vice versa. Her role as translator in the association has been essential to Croatian, Bosnian and Albanian refugees who fled their lands violently. Mrs. Behide Hasanaj also contributed to the sheltering of many refugees throughout Switzerland. In 1986, she began work at "Neprentechnikerin Spezialist" company, where in addition to her role as a supervisor in the association, she returned to her first profession as a tailor for sewing police and military clothing for the Swiss state. In 1991, she completed a room maintenance course and worked as a staff supervisor at "Wetrok" company. She started work at a seminar hotel hosted by European countries. In 1992, she completed a study to help people with disabilities and mental illness in Bern and Thun, helping many people in need. Her activities continued uninterrupted succession. In 1997 she began volunteering as an assistant physician at the state hospital for people with special needs. Mrs. Behide Hasanaj's activity at the charity "Mother Teresa" branch in Thun continued for many years, where she helped thousands of refugees who took the long way to emigration during the Kosovo war.

She assisted refugees in housing and meeting their urgent needs while staying in Switzerland. Her hard work and contribution began in this period. Alongside her own incomes, she took the initiative and knocked on many doors, appealing to every corner of the Swiss state as well as around the world to raise funds to help people who were expelled from Kosovo.

For post-war state building she called on all Swiss compatriots and citizens as well as many organizations, institutions for aid and contributions to the people of Kosovo. When the war in Kosovo broke out in 1997-1998, she took courage and with love for the homeland, as a coordinator of the German language in Switzerland and Kosovo, transported and supervised the aid to Kosovo of "Mother Theresa" association and made everyone stand up and help the people of Kosovo.

Her meetings and self-confidence had great success in raising funds both before the war and after the war in Kosovo. Mrs. Behide Hasanaj did not stop her activity, will and help. She always called for help and contributions. In 2000, for state-building, she began successive visits to Kosovo to help the people, where she, together with many Swiss humanitarians, came to help many cities and villages affected by the war. Her willingness to work was immense. In 2002, Mrs. Behide Hasanaj founded "FPA-Planung GMBH" company, with the aim of assisting Kosovar immigrants with financial insurance in Switzerland. She also provided assistance to the families of post-war victims of staying and sheltering in Switzerland. Mrs. Behide Hasanaj has contributed to the construction of hospitals in Kosovo and has assisted people with disabilities and family members affected by the war. She received many gratitude throughout the country, both at home and abroad, which made her a great figure and highly valued by her people. During this time, she has continued her humanity by frequently traveling to her hometown to help people in need. She helped many women who had been victims of violence during the Kosovo war and who were in extreme poverty helping them with medication, food, clothing, etc. She also helped orphaned children living in poverty following the injuries sustained during the Kosovo war. In May 2013, she requested the people of Kosovo and the Swiss people to help mothers and sisters who were victims of violence during the Kosovo war to help them alleviate their pain, to help the children of martyrs and families living in poverty. As a result of her contribution, confidence and skills, Ms. Behide Hasanaj is decorated with gratitude and thanks for her hard work and punctuality in the association.

In 2013, Ms. Behide Hasanaj sold her property in Kosovo and donated the money to orphaned children and those in poor health. She still continues without stopping to contribute and organize successive aids to all peoples. Mrs. Behide Hasanaj is one of the first to help the Albanian population and contribute tirelessly, a fact that will always remain in the hearts and memories of many people who have met her personally and had the opportunity to be part of her great help.
